#### **Data Sources:**

State industry employment data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (QCEW) using the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS). Note: Pharmaceutical manufacturing industry statistics (above) do not represent the entirety of the pharmaceutical and biotech industry featured in this study. Most significantly, in addition to NAICS 325400 ("Pharmaceutical Manufacturing"), other industry jobs comprise a subset of NAICS 541700 ("Scientific R&D Services").
